In the case of returning residents of Fiji, the goods should have been owned and used by such passenger for twelve months prior to his departure for Fiji. 	<p>The owner in the presence of a Customs Officer must sign the baggage declaration form.</p> <p>To qualify for duty and VAT free concessions, the owner should have either a work permit or residence status, and should be in the country at the time of arrival of effects, to facilitate customs clearance (takes approximately 5 days).</p> <p>Owner should have a visa of 12 months or in case of returning residents should have resided overseas for more than 12 months and goods shipped within 12 months of date of arrival approve clearance.</p> <p>Another option is to pay a deposit based on the value declared which is refunded once the visa is approved.</p>
