GOODS	DOCUMENTS REQUIRED	CUSTOMS PRESCRIPTIONS	REMARKS
DOCUMENTS REQUIRED	<ul> <li>Original passport showing entry stamp in Madagascar and visa long stay 1 year.</li> <li>Passport with a residence visa or resident card in the country of departure (valid for more than one year upon arrival).</li> <li>Proof of break of stay in case of passage on Madagascar during the last twelve months before final arrival or trip out of Madagascar after final arrival.</li> <li>Shipper's flight ticket related to last trip to Madagascar.</li> <li>Original boarding passes related to last trip to Madagascar with all connecting flights.</li> <li>2 certified copies of the passport by the Malagasy town hall in Madagascar.</li> <li>Original of Certificate of change of residence from Madagascar embassy at origin.</li> <li>Original of valued Inventory in French or English without error and no zero-value declared for any item. Must be signed and dated by shipper and stamped by Madagascar embassy at origin.</li> <li>Original of Certificate of change of residence</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>The shipper must be present in Madagascar because the original passport is needed.</li> <li>Vehicle of non-diplomatic shipment is inspected by CIVIO (used vehicle identification control) for obtaining the value for clearance customs (duration about 15 days more or less).</li> <li>Non-diplomatic shippers must apply for tax exemption to customs authorities and must pay GASYNET tax at arrival.</li> <li>Tax exemption is issued to each person for one time during his life.</li> <li>Tax-free must be submitted not more than 6 months after obtaining the Malagasy long stay/residency visa for foreigners. For Malagasy citizen count start from the day they arrived in Madagascar.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>All shipments are inspected except diplomatic shipments.</li> <li>Old passport is requested in case the new one has been delivered less than one year at time of tax-free submission.</li> <li>BSC: cargo tracking note:         <ul> <li>You can contact the person in charge of issuing it at MG.BSC@sgs.com – web site: http://www.bscmg.sgs.com) or</li> <li>Best is however to ask your destination agent to handle this for you.</li> </ul> </li> <li>All listed documents are needed for tax-free import. If one is missing, no tax free. Some document looks similar (flight ticket &amp; boarding passes) but both are needed.</li> <li>In case there is no Madagascar representation at origin country, the document must be stamped at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in Antananarivo.</li> <li>Shipper will be requested to meet the customs inspector few days before the shipment arrival.</li> <li>Original of Certificate of change of residence</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>Original engagement letter dully filled and legalized by the Malagasy City town hall.</li> <li>Original handwritten letter of exemption request to be addressed to "The Head of Legislation and Regulation Services".</li> <li>Original Attestation of gratuitousness dully filled and legalized by the Malagasy City town hall.</li> <li>Original packing list.</li> <li>Bill of lading (waybill or express release is better) / air waybill (AWB)).</li> <li>Copy of customs export declaration.</li> <li>Copy of the "Jirama" bill (water and electricity bill in Madagascar)</li> <li>For foreign worker:         <ul> <li>Work permit from Labour Ministry in Madagascar.</li> <li>Original of Employment Attestation at Madagascar.</li> <li>For Malagasy returning Citizens:                  <ul> <li>2 certified copies of the Malagasy National Identity Card.</li> <li>For foreign pensioner:</li></ul></li></ul></li></ul>	All import sea shipments attract an APMF fee that will only be known during clearance.

	<ul> <li>Attestation of non-Employment by the EDBM (Economic Development Board of Madagascar) in Madagascar.</li> <li>For diplomats:         <ul> <li>Attestation of Destination.</li> <li>Transit order by the Organism or Embassy.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>		<ul> <li>This tax exemption done by the diplomat employer.</li> <li>Diplomats shall provide less documents than in the first section above:</li> <li>Copy of official passport with mention "DIPLOMAT",</li> <li>Packing list,</li> <li>Valued inventory list,</li> <li>Attestation of destination,</li> <li>Transit order.</li> <li>Depending on the employer, 1 or 2 additional documents might be required.</li> </ul>
DUTIABLE/RESTRICTED ITEMS		<ul> <li>Food and consumable items: all canned meat products (including pork, sheep, fish, chicken, etc.) must have a Certificate of Health.</li> <li>Electrical items and furniture must be more than six months old; otherwise, they are subject to Customs duties and taxes.</li> <li>Home computers, hardware product and professional equipment (as tools, generator) are not accepted as personal effects and are subject to Customs duties and taxes.</li> <li>Books and DVD's (audio and video) require an agreement from the Interior Ministry.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>All kind of tools and new furniture are dutiable.</li> <li>No matter number of family member, bicycle, TV, computer, fridge, freezer, cooker are limited 2 per family. 3rd piece will be dutiable.</li> <li>Printer, copier, scanner and video projector are limited only 1 per family. 2nd piece will be dutiable.</li> <li>Items considered as professional will be dutiable.</li> <li>Any kind of tools or similar, electric or not will be dutiable.</li> </ul>
PROHIBITED ITEMS		<ul> <li>Weapons, ammunition, military equipment.</li> <li>Drugs and narcotics.</li> <li>Alcohol and other spirits (if excess the allowed quantities)</li> <li>Animal skins, stuffed animals, birds or fish.</li> <li>CBs and walkie-talkies (including children's toys).</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Allowed quantities:</li> <li>2 litres of each for of champagne and whisky.</li> <li>4 litres of each for the wine, sparkle wine and liquor.</li> </ul>

MOTOR VEHICLES	Original car registration card / title.	<ul> <li>Import duty &amp; tax is exempt if the registration papers have been in the name of the qualifying shipper for more than one year.</li> <li>Import duties &amp; tax will apply if the registration documents have been in the name of the shipper for less than one year.</li> <li>Import duties &amp; tax might apply on the shipment if the visa long stay is less than 12 months + 1 day.</li> <li>One shipper can import tax-free one car and one motorbike.</li> <li>If shipper is moving with family he can, under condition, tax-free import a second car but the family member must move (more or less) same date like him/her and provide all requested document as in the first HHGs section above.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>In addition to all required document for HHGs import, in case there is a car, shipper must provide additionally those documents.</li> <li>Quads, sidecar, tricycle, buggy, goods transport vehicle and vehicle equal or more than 10 places are dutiable</li> <li>Right hand vehicle cannot be imported.</li> <li>It is often happening that the Malagasy immigration grant less than 12 months residency visa.</li> </ul>
PETS	<ul> <li>Certificate of good health dated within three days of arrival.</li> <li>Rabies vaccination (within 30-180 days prior to arrival).</li> </ul>	Shipping as unaccompanied baggage is not recommended.
