| Diplomats removals | <ul> <li>Application for free entry on form 14.60 to<br/>be made by Embassy to the Customs Office<br/>of importation as requested.</li> </ul>  | <ul> <li>Application to be forwarded to the nearest customs office i.e. to Genève-La Praille or Bern, where the formalities for duty-free importation will be carried out.</li> <li>Import of alcohol is allowed for diplomats but limited to annual quota agreed by the local Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the respective embassies in the country.</li> </ul>   | <ul> <li>Customs form on file with most foreign<br/>Embassies and Consulates.</li> <li>Copies are not accepted – original signature<br/>is mandatory.</li> </ul>   |

| Inheritance                       | <ul> <li>Customs form 18.46.</li> <li>Inventory of the goods with supporting legal declaration or will confirming that the goods to be imported are the rightful property of the inheritor.</li> <li>Certificate of death or equivalent document confirming the last residence of the deceased.</li> <li>Passport copy of inheritor.</li> </ul> | <ul> <li>Duty free entry provided:</li> <li>Inheritor has residence in Switzerland at the time of death and at the time of import.</li> <li>Only used household goods and effects can be imported duty-free as inheritance goods</li> </ul> | Your destination agent will provide the<br>Swiss customs form 18.46. Copies are not<br>accepted – original signature is mandatory.   |
| New furniture and household goods | <ul> <li>Purchase Invoice.</li> <li>Forms EUR 1 certificate of origin where applicable, to allow duty-free entry (EEC/EFTA-countries) or entry at reduced rates from some other countries.</li> </ul>   | <ul> <li>All new items are subject to duties and taxes payment.</li> <li>Duty is charged by weight.</li> <li>Taxes: VAT is charged at 7.7%.</li> </ul>  | <ul> <li>Must be declared separately according to customs tariff headings.</li> <li>Individual weights on invoice or packing list are helpful.</li> </ul>  |
| Art work                          | <ul> <li>Inventory list showing the art work:</li> <li>Name.</li> <li>Year of production.</li> <li>Author/artist.</li> <li>Value (if possible).</li> <li>Information is required for statistical data.</li> </ul>   | Duty free without special documents if part of a removal.   | <ul> <li>If not part of a removal, same as under 'new'<br/>furniture, but duty and tax-free when<br/>imported by the artist himself.</li> </ul>  |
| Antiques                          | <ul> <li>See under Works of art.</li> <li>If not part of a removal: invoice with confirmation that they are over 100 years old.</li> </ul>  | <ul> <li>Antiques can be imported duty free but are<br/>liable to VAT taxes, see under 'new'<br/>furniture.</li> </ul>  |  |

| Motor vehicles (cars, boats, planes etc.) | <ul> <li>Documents as mentioned under "removal goods" plus:</li> <li>Purchase contract/receipt.</li> <li>Original title or registration card</li> </ul>   | <ul> <li>Duty free entry provided when:</li> <li>The imported vehicle has been in use and possession by client for at least 6 months prior to shipping.</li> </ul>   | <ul> <li>Third party liability insurance is mandatory for the registration and use of a vehicle on Swiss roads.</li> <li>Vehicle cannot be used without number plate (foreign or Swiss).</li> <li>Customs may ask for proof of the first registration/official use of car.</li> </ul> |
| Alcoholic beverages (wine, beer etc.)     | To be declared on separate inventory.   | <ul> <li>Duty free if part of removal and in a reasonable quantity appropriate to the amount of removal goods (max. 200 litres of wine).</li> <li>Import of alcohol is allowed for diplomats but limited to annual quota agreed by the local Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the respective embassies in the country.</li> </ul> | <ul> <li>Load to allow easy access for inspection. If<br/>bought especially for export and not in<br/>owners possession prior to the move,<br/>dutiable, and may be subject to import<br/>quotas.</li> </ul>  |
| Strong liquor (over 25% proof)            | Must be declared on separate inventory.   | Duty free up to 12 litres.   | <ul> <li>For additional quantity, very heavy duty and<br/>taxes are applied (over SFr.50 per bottle).</li> </ul>  |

| Fumigation of imported and exported wooden materials |   | <ul> <li>Effective October 2010 the Swiss         Government adopted ISPM-15 standards for         wood packaging.</li> <li>Wooden packing material imported from         outside of Europe and from Portugal are         subject to heated treatment proofed with an         according ISPM Seal.</li> </ul> | <ul> <li>The wooden packing material must be marked in a visible location on each article, if possible on two opposite sides of the package.</li> <li>Currently the random samples will only be examined at the Swiss customs boarder in Basel.</li> <li>Consult www.spedlogswiss.com.</li> </ul> |
