

Importation options: As a tourist: Temporary customs clearance. Customer can drive vehicle in Greece with foreign plates for six months. After that period vehicle has to be re-exported or registered in Greece and get Greek plates Payment of taxes/duties when applicable the amount depends on vehicle's cc, model, type, and gas exhaust measurements etc. Certificate of repatriation: Tax & duty free status. Customer will pay for registration fees and any other local tax fee. As a diplomat: diplomatic franchise required. 	 Regarding motorbikes, their chassis has to have at least seventeen (17) digits. Either car or motorbike has to be under the latest European manufacturing standards (in order to get Greek plates. It is highly recommended that you contact with your destination agent to determine first of all if vehicle can be registered into Greece and if so what the cost would be.
